### Hospital Information

The South West Health Service District is the largest, covering an area of 319 870 square kilometres, and most rural and remote districts in the Southern Area Health Service. The district services eleven hospitals, including Augathella, Charleville, Cunnamulla, Dirranbandi, Injune, Mitchell, Mungindi, Quilpie, Roma, St George and Surat, and four outpatient clinics, including Bollon, Morven, Thargomindah and Wallumbilla, two Primary Health Care Units, two aged care residential facilities and the Flying Specialist Service, based in Roma. The Flying Specialist Service consists of a surgeon, an obstetrician / gynaecologist, two anaesthetists and an Obstetrics & Gynaecology registrar, all with right of private practice. In addition to medical and nursing services, the larger hospitals located at Roma, St George and Charleville provide public health services in pharmacy, radiography, pathology, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, mental health, social work, dietetics, cardiac rehabilitation, podiatry, speech pathology, counselling and dentistry. The smaller facilities within the district either have some of these services on a permanent basis or receive them on a semi-regular basis through visiting clinics provided by staff from larger health facilities. Roma Hospital also has visiting medical specialists. The Roma Hospital, located to the east, is the major hospital for the Eastern Sector of the South West Health Service District, servicing 40 acute beds and 40 high and low nursing care beds in the Westhaven Aged Care Facility, on the same campus.

Pharmacists registered in the UK, Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland may be eligible for registration as a pharmacist in Queensland, subject to reciprocal agreement requirements, satisfactory completion of four weeks supervised training and a satisfactory assessment interview.
